

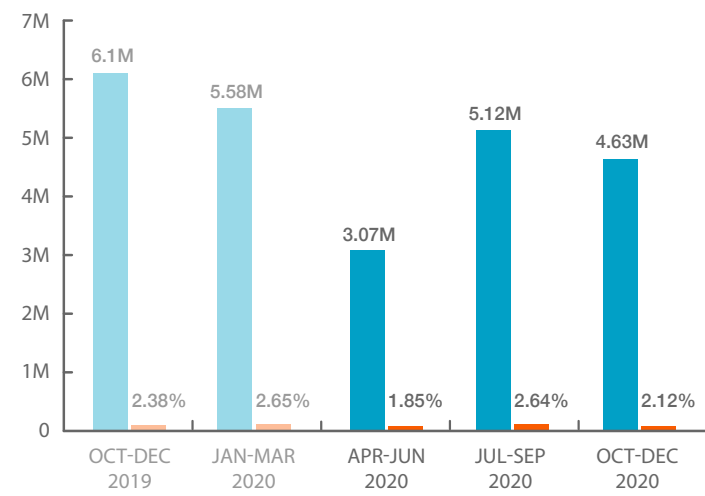
**DURING OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2020:**

- **ALMOST 90% OF UNREGISTERED JOURNEYS PAID FOR THROUGH MERSEYFLOW APP OR WEBSITE** – a new record for payment through digital channels
- **PCNs CONTINUE TO FALL AS A PERCENTAGE OF JOURNEY NUMBERS** – journey levels dropped by 24% compared to this time last year, whereas PCNs have dropped by 32%
- **JOURNEY NUMBERS ONLY DOWN SLIGHTLY IN NOVEMBER RESTRICTIONS** – average daily traffic levels in November were twice as high as they were in the April lockdown
- **ALMOST 98% OF JOURNEYS WERE PAID FOR ON TIME** – the vast majority of people are paying for their journeys by midnight the day after they cross

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge. It is not retained by the council or any of its contractors.

**Quarterly journey numbers down by almost 10%**

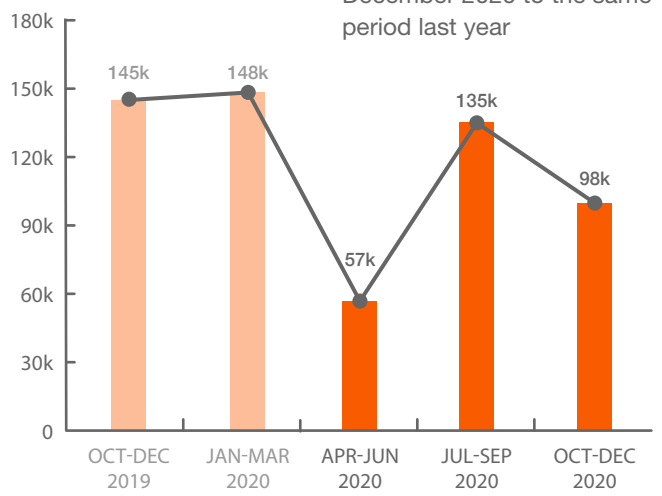
**Total journeys and number of PCNs issued**



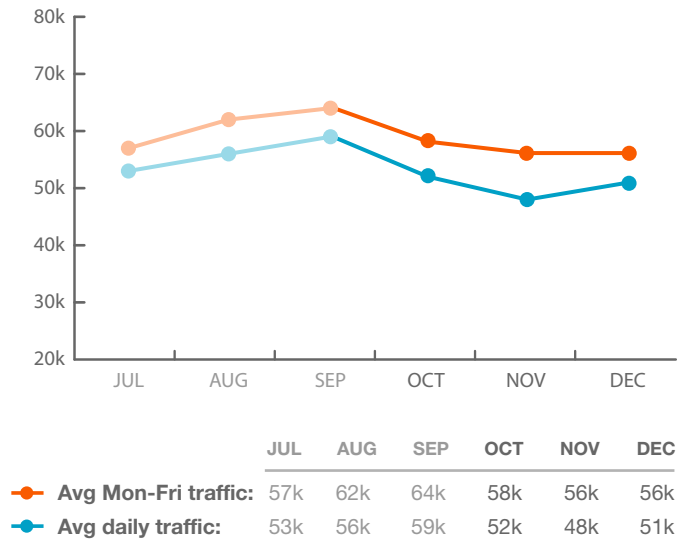
**PCNs decrease by 32%\* – a drop of 47,000**

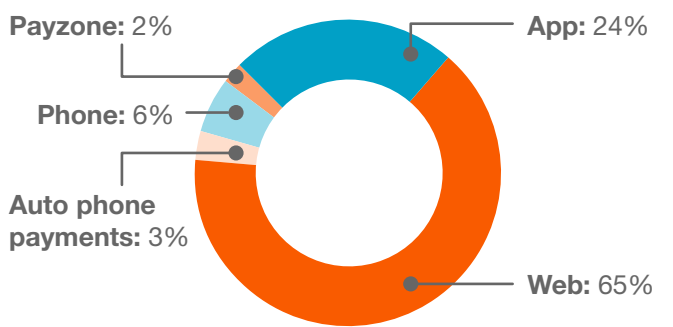


**Average traffic (in 000s)**

**Almost 98% of customers paid their toll/charge on time**

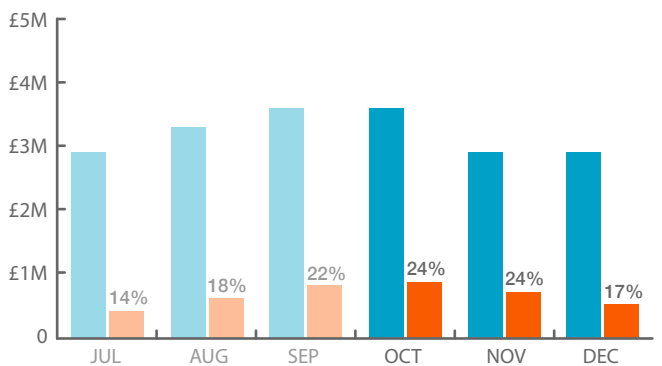
