

# Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridge statistics

APRIL TO JUNE 2021

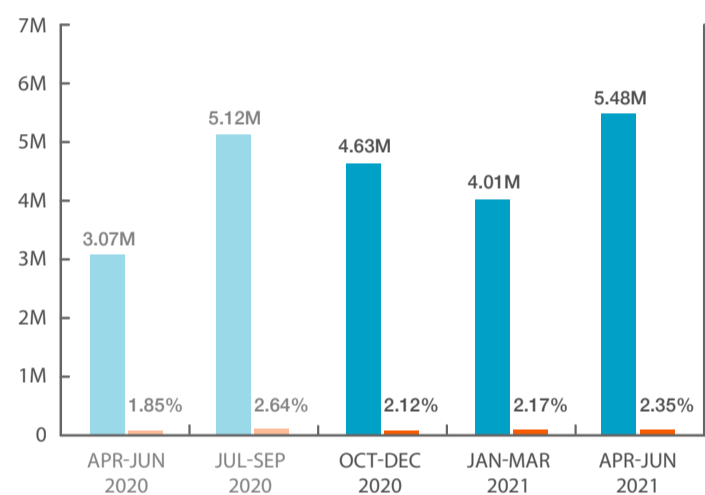
## DURING APRIL TO JUNE 2021:

- **TRAFFIC LEVELS IN JUNE 2021 WERE BACK TO 95% OF PRE-PANDEMIC VOLUMES** – June 2021 was the busiest month across the river since February 2020
- **JUST OVER 13% OF TOTAL JOURNEYS ACROSS THE RIVER MERSEY FROM APRIL TO JUNE WERE ACROSS THE SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE** – but this is an amazing ten times less than the amount of traffic the Silver Jubilee Bridge used to carry
- **ALMOST 98% OF JOURNEYS WERE PAID FOR ON TIME** – the vast majority of people are paying for their journeys by midnight the day after they cross
- **PCNs (PENALTY CHARGE NOTICES) INCREASE AS EXPECTED AS TOTAL JOURNEY NUMBERS RISE** – but the level of PCNs issued as a percentage of overall journeys continues to remain low at less than 2.5%
- **OVER 130,000 CUSTOMERS HAVE NOW DOWNLOADED THE MERSEYFLOW QUICK PAY APP** – the vast majority of payments for one-off journeys are now being made via the app or the merseyflow website

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge. It is not retained by the council or any of its contractors.

### Quarterly journey numbers increase by almost 1.5 million

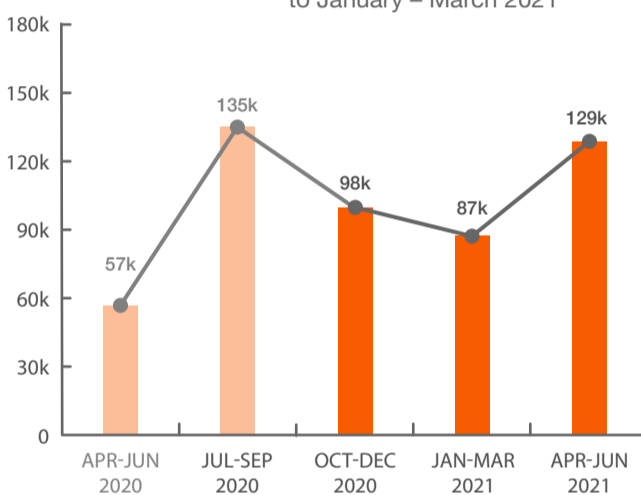
#### Total journeys and number of PCNs issued



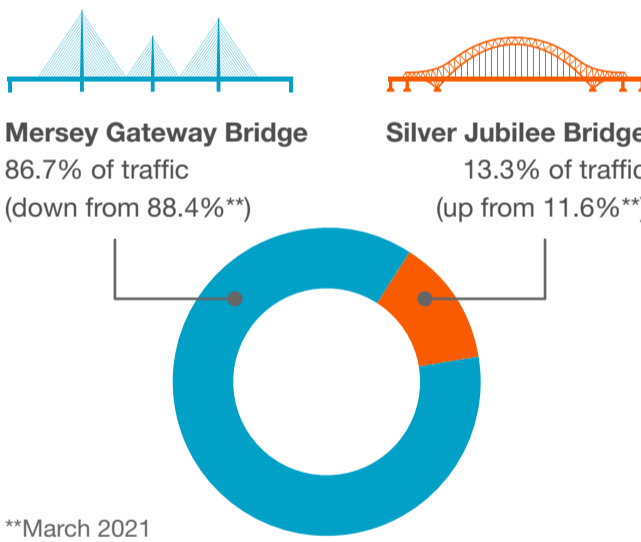
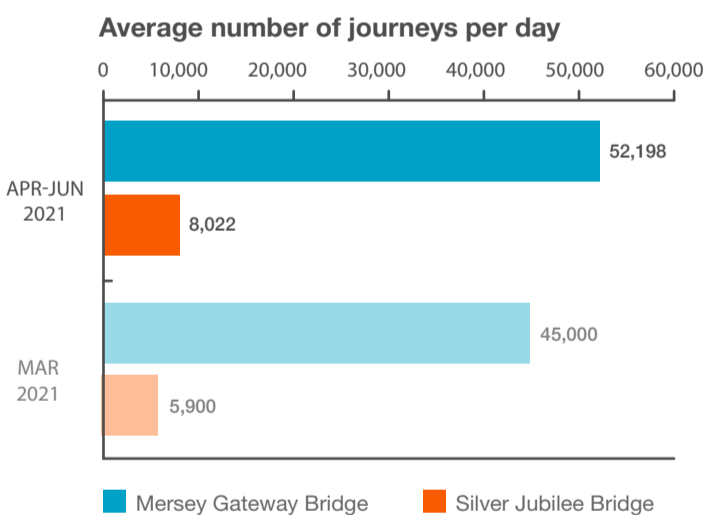
### PCNs increase\* as expected as journey numbers rise

## Bridge usage from April – June 2021

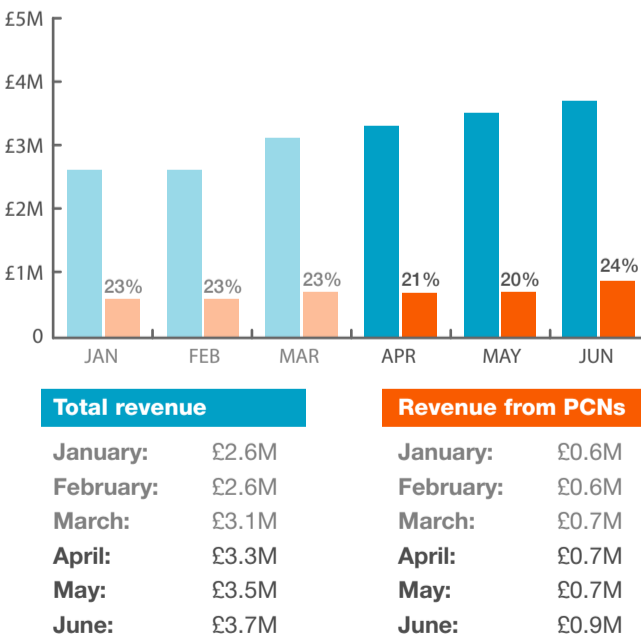


## Total journeys and Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs)
